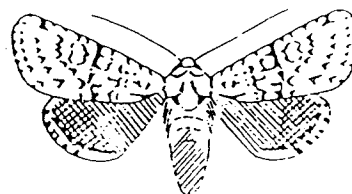

WINTER INDOOR MEETING -25th FEBRUARY

17 members attended the meeting at Kenfig NNR and helped to identify a number of species on slide that had not previously been captioned. One member also brought a collection of moths & butterflies assembled several decades ago.

GOOD NEWS ABOUT BLAIR

No, not Tony Blair - but Blair's Wainscot (*Sedina buettneri*) - though a number of fanciful connections between this newly rediscovered moth and the Prime Minister have been made in the national press. After the passage of almost 50 years in which the moth was believed extinct in Britain, it turned up in a number of locations along a Dorset river valley.

Like many related Wainscot species, Blair's Wainscot lives in marshes and fens. The adult is well camouflaged amongst the leaves and stems of reeds and sedges. It has a larva which feeds and eventually pupates inside a stem of its food plant, *Carex acutiformis*.

The species was first noted in Britain in 1945 by Dr. Kenneth G. Blair, not long after Labour's landslide election victory, in a marsh at Freshwater on the Isle of Wight. Sadly, though this was the only known site for the species, the marsh was later drained and the burned. Predictably the moth disappeared. Ironically, this extinction occurred around the time Labour fell from power in the early 1950's. The moth seemed to have gone forever, only to reappear in 1997 along with another Labour landslide. One other symbolic link with Labour is that the species is tinged with delicate pink streaks on its forewings !

An encouraging fact about the rediscovery of this moth is that it was made not by a moth group or an independent moth enthusiast but by Butterfly Conservation members. This is a good indication of the increasing attention BC as an organisation is giving to these equally interesting and more numerous relatives of the butterflies.

BC is the principle conservation body in the UK for all Lepidoptera, both butterflies & moths. It would be a very desirable and positive step forward for the conservation of all Lepidoptera if an increase in the profile and perception of BC's role was to open up a source of recruits for BC among the thousands of moth enthusiasts around Britain.

AUGUST FIELD MEETING

RECENT REPORTS

Kenfig NNR.

A trap set especially for the members evening on the 25th February produced a few moths, one of which **Northern Drab** was only the 10th record for KNNR and a "tick" for most observers present. Other moths there included Early Grey, Red Chestnut, Chestnut, Pale Brindled Beauty, March Moth, Early Moth, Clouded Drab, Common Quaker and Hebrew Character. At Whitchurch in Cardiff a Dotted Border was present on 24th. Micro news : *Agonopterix herachiana* was reported from Whitchurch and Kenfig 24th & 25th.

ORANGE UNDERWINGS

To date only Orange Underwing (*Archiearis parthenias*) has been recorded in Glamorgan although Light Orange Underwing (*A. notha*) occurs as close as South Gloucestershire. Orange Underwing is a day flying species, often very active in sunshine around the tops of Birch trees, flying in March and April. Look carefully for the species in woods containing Birch as it is clearly much under-recorded in our birch rich county. The rarer species also flies during March and April, favours Aspen. Unfortunately most of the Aspen in the county is planted although there are natural stands so it is worth looking out for where the tree occurs.
